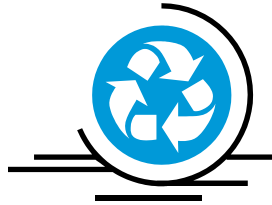


Earth Day Project

Directions: Students will use 3 or more recycled/found items to create a new object. The created object can be functional or a work of art. Students can be as creative as they would like. They can even invent something new! The created object should be no larger than 10"x10"x10" and should be able to be set up on a desk for display.

Plan: Students should complete the attached plan for their project. Students should use many details in their plan.

Materials: Most materials used should be found/recycled objects such as toilet paper rolls, paper or plastic cups, empty boxes, etc. Students may also use items such as tape, crayons, markers, paint, glue to aide in the project-making process.

Presentation: Students will set up their project on their desk for a gallery walk.

Criteria: Creations will be graded using the attached rubric.


